Update on Activities at the Rehoboth Art League

At the Rehoboth Art League, we believe that the health and well-being of our community comes first, and yesterday's guidance from the State of Delaware now indicates that large gatherings should be avoided. As a result, we have decided to cancel the opening reception of our Young at Art Exhibition scheduled for tomorrow, March 14th. Celebrating the work of our young artists is of utmost importance to us, and while their artwork is already installed in our galleries, we will not be able to host a public gathering in its honor. We ask for your understanding in making this decision, which we believe is in the best interest of our community.

Our scheduled classes and open studios will continue as planned, as they are all programs that are small in participant numbers. The administration of the Rehoboth Art League, along with its galleries and campus, will remain open at this time, and we are taking additional precautions to clean and disinfect areas with more frequent traffic. Major events in coming months will remain on our calendar and we will continue to reassess them each week as additional directions from public health authorities develop.

We want to advise the community that there have been no confirmed cases of COVID-19 at the Rehoboth Art League, and we will continue to monitor CDC guidelines, as well as information from state and county health officials. We ask that if any of our members, artists, or visitors are not feeling well to please refrain from visiting the campus so that our community can continue to remain healthy.
