SIDEWALK SALES RULES/REGULATIONS—CITY OF REHOBOTH BEACH MERCHANTS:

There is no registration required to participate in the annual Sidewalk Sales; however City of Rehoboth Beach merchants must observe the following rules & regulations:

- Sidewalk sales are specifically for City of Rehoboth Beach businesses that own, operate, and are licensed to do business at their respective storefronts.
- All tables, chairs, etc. should be removed from the sidewalks by 9:00 PM.
- Licensed merchants shall set up directly in front of their business store front.
- The business entrance must be clear and open to the public.
- Pedestrian walkways must be open to the public.
- Tents are not permitted.
- Restaurants may set up and sell food directly in front of their business provided they adhere to all related Department of Health regulations.

NOTE: The City of Rehoboth Beach and Chamber of Commerce remind the Rehoboth Beach business community that the Sidewalk Sale is **only for the operator/owner of the business with store frontage in the City of Rehoboth Beach. Outside vendors are not permitted. The Rehoboth Beach enforcement officer has been made aware of the situation and will be enforcing the rules.**
