REHOBOTH BEACH HOMETOWN CHRISTMAS PARADE-TUESDAY, DECEMBER 2

The Rehoboth Beach Volunteer Fire Company has provided confirmation that tonight's Christmas Parade is proceeding as planned – the parade starts at 6:30 PM.

REHOBOTH BEACH SEASHORE MARATHON/HALF MARATHON

The Rehoboth Beach Seashore Marathon and Half Marathon will be held this Saturday, **December 6**, from 7 a.m.-2 p.m. There are 2,600 runners registered and Rehoboth Beach Running Company expects 7,500 people downtown for this event. The majority of the runners come into town early Friday afternoon. Following is a brief summary of the events scheduled throughout this week: Friday, Dec. 5- Noon to 8pm - Racers pick up their packages in the Cultured Pearl - the restaurant will be open for food & drink at Noon. Saturday, Dec. 6 -7am - the race begins at the Bandstand; 8:15 -the first half marathoners finish (Awards at 10:00 in The Cultured Pearl); 9:45 - the first full marathoners finish (Awards at 11:30 in The Cultured Pearl); 3:00 - the last runners should be in by 3:00 and the race will end. By Friday evening, Dec. 5, 4th Street and portions of Rehoboth Avenue and Sussex Street will be closed. In addition, the Marathon barricades, tents, time clocks, cameras and the finish line will be set up on 4th Street.
